RE: PROPERTY OWNERS MEETING FOR PROPOSED DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE SANITARY SEWERS IN DEVOLA

Dear Property Owner:

On behalf of the Washington County Commissioners, we would like to invite you to attend a meeting regarding the proposed project to design and construct a new phase of sanitary sewers in Devola.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 14th from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm at the Washington State Community College located at 710 Colegate Drive, Marietta, Ohio 45750, Graham Auditorium.

The purpose of this meeting is to present the information we currently have for this project and to gather additional data to move forward with the design.

The project will involve the design and construction of a new central sanitary sewer to serve Phase II within the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's (OEPA) defined service area. This proposed sanitary sewer will tie into the existing Phase I system, which then flows downstream to the Devola lift station located at 4441 Hwy 60, south of Devola. As you are probably aware, this activity is following the court ordered mandate to comply with the OPEA Director's Final Findings and Orders.
